JOIN US for a Rally and Silent Walk on Friday, June 15 beginning at noon at Rosa Parks Square at the corner of First and Poplar Streets in front of City Hall. We will have a Rally featuring pro-life leader Rev. Walter B. Hoye II, and then walk together to the proposed site at 833 Walnut Street.

FACTS ABOUT THE RALLY & SILENT MARCH

- 1. WHAT:** Rally featuring pro-life leader Rev. Walter B. Hoye II. Followed by a silent, prayerful walk.
- 2. WHY:** Abortionists are trying to open an abortion facility in Macon at 833 Walnut Street.

3. **WHEN:** Friday, June 15 at 12:00, noon.

4. **WHERE:** Rosa Parks Square at the corner of First and Poplar Streets in front of City Hall.

5. **WHO:** All citizens concerned about an Atlanta and Detroit abortion business exploiting women in Macon.

Who is Georgia Right to Life?
